
## L'Europe à vol d'oiseau

Profesor Triangulix, a top-notch surveyor, is interested in European cities. He knows a few direct distances between cities, as the crow flies:

from Strasbourg (F) to Constance (D): 151 km from Constance to Padua (I): 320 km from Padua to Brussels (B): 813 km from Brussels to Luxembourg (L): 196 km from Luxembourg to Saarbrucken (D): 53 km from Saarbrucken to Strasbourg: 93 km.
